

Public Hearing for Discontinuance of a Number of Streets and Alleys in Waukau, Rushford Township Minutes
Wednesday, December 7, 2016

12 residents signed the attendance list, though more were present.

Tom Egan opened the Public Hearing at 6:30 pm explaining that we would have discussion and then adjourn the hearing until February. Tom Egan opened discussion by stating that a decision would not be made at this time, for the DNR is concerned that the intersection on Commercial & East Street might provide public access to Waukau Creek. The DNR needs to approve any street discontinuance in order for this to be effective. The DNR can override anything the Town decides on. It was discussed that Sue Metko has a garage at the end of Commercial Street. Fred Kasten asked for clarification if they were concerned with spill ways or total access. The DNR is concerned with public access ways. Jim Smith and the attorney will be working with this with the hearing being adjourned for determination in February. It was asked if the Town could close the rest that are not in question. The Town would like to wait and do all the roads and alleys at once.
