DISASTER DECLARATION FOR TOWN OF RUSHFORD, WINNEBAGO COUNTY JULY 24, 2022

WHEREAS on July 23, 2022, a disaster, namely wind damage from storm, has struck the Town of Rushford; and

WHEREAS, because of such emergency conditions, the Town Board is unable to meet with promptness; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, welfare and good order of the Town to proclaim that emergency conditions exits; and

WHEREAS, the disaster has caused the Town of Rushford to expand, commit and exhaust all of its available resources; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Rushford is asking for county assistance and requests the county to advise the State of Wisconsin of our emergency conditions:

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to sections 323.11 and 323.14 (4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, as Chief Elected Official of the Town of Rushford in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and have caused the great seal of the Town of Rushford to be affixed.
