

FINAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT
AND LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS AGAINST BENEFITTED PROPERTY
IN THE TOWN OF RUSHFORD, WISCONSIN.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Rushford, Winnebago County, Wisconsin, held a public hearing at the Rushford Town Hall at 6:30 p.m. on the day of November 2nd, 2016, for the purpose of hearing all interested persons concerning the preliminary resolution and report of the Town on the proposed public improvements consisting of road improvements and preliminary assessments against benefitted property, and heard all persons who desired to speak at the hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Rushford, Wisconsin, determines as follows:

1. The report of the Town, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully set forth herein, including the plans and specifications and assessments set forth therein, is adopted and approved.

2. Payment for the improvements shall be made by assessing the entire cost to the property benefitted as indicated in the report.

3. Assessments shown on the report represent an exercise of the police power and have been determined on a reasonable basis and are hereby confirmed.

4. Assessments for all projects included in the report are hereby combined as a single assessment but any interested property owner may object to each assessment separately or all assessments jointly for any purpose.

5. Assessments shall be due by November 26, 2016. Assessments may be paid in cash or in 3 annual installments to the municipal clerk. Installments shall be placed on the next tax roll after the due date for collection and shall bear interest at the rate of 3.57 % per annum on the unpaid balance from due date. Installments or assessments not paid when due shall bear additional interest on the amount due at the rate of 3.57 % per annum.

6. The town clerk shall publish this resolution as a class 1 notice under ch. 985, Stats., in the assessment district and mail a copy of this resolution and a statement of the final assessment against the benefitted property together with notice of installment payment privileges to every property owner whose name appears on the assessment roll whose post office address is known or can with reasonable diligence be ascertained.
